#### Sound Workshop Part I: Building a Bat Detector with Estraven Lupino-Smith

Political ecology and art collide in this two part workshop offered by featured artist Estraven Lupino-Smith. In the first part, you'll build a bat detector, and learn about the physics of sound, how bats make noise, and basic field recording techniques. You'll then put your new skills to work in Part 2 of the workshop.

#### Precipice of a Story with Taryn Walker

Meet featured artist Taryn Walker and hear her speak about her process in developing the site specific drawing installation located at Venue 833. Taryn's work is a hybrid between traditional illustrative and muralist techniques. She uses these methods to delve into our associations between drawing, storytelling, and language.

#### Sound Workshop Part II: Field Recording with Estraven Lupino-Smith

Examine the ramifications of shifting urban, suburban, and rural environments of wildlife through this sound art workshop about bats. Learn about art and its intersections with research, citizen science, and the natural world.
